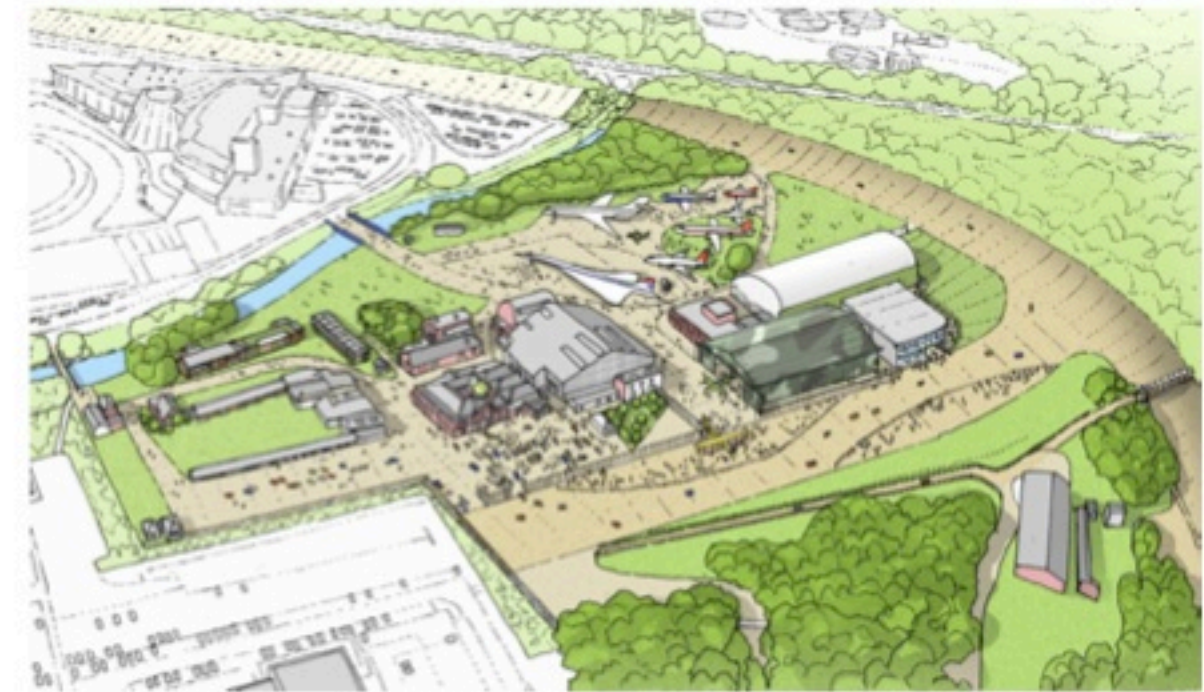
Summary:

Brooklands presents the **history of both motor racing and aircraft manufacture** over the last 100 years. Opened in 1991 it is home to the **world's first purpose-built racing circuit**. A **major redevelopment** project will **relocate, restore and reinterpret a Grade 2-listed hangar** and see the construction of a **new annexe** to house the museum's collection of historic aircraft and new exhibitions. They will also **restore** the section of **original race track** on which the hangar currently stands. There will be enhanced **learning opportunities** and a **training scheme** in historic aircraft restoration. As this book was published they were **tendering** for a Project Manager, Fundraising Consultant, Design Team and an Exhibition Designer, with the intention of submitting a **HLF stage 2 application for £4.85m in 2015**.
