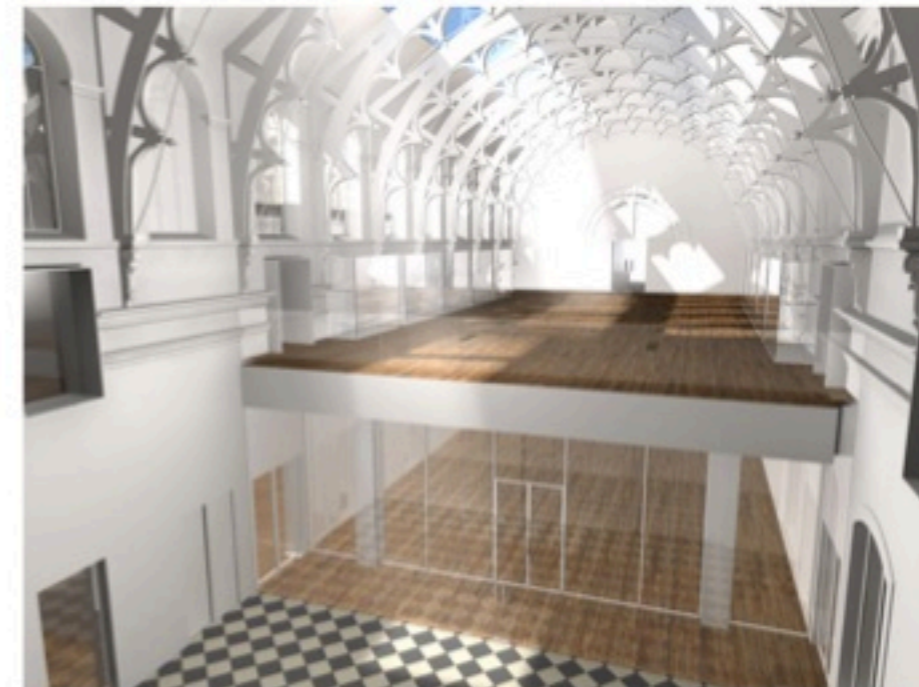
Summary:

York Art Gallery have **ambitious plans** to make a 'must see' arts destination by **fully developing** the footprint of the existing 19th-century building. Spaces to be redeveloped include the '**secret gallery**' in the roof void of the main gallery as well as the spaces currently occupied by the **City Archives**. These new areas will allow for **expanded exhibition** and learning facilities. The plan also includes creating a **connection** with the **gardens** at the rear of the gallery, which will provide opportunities for **outdoor exhibitions** and performance. The project team is led by **Ushida Findlay** who worked on the Arcelor Mittal Orbit at the **Olympic Park**.
