SUMMARY

Detailed plans are underway for a new extension to the Museum of Barnstaple and North Devon, which displays collections of local natural and human history and includes the Tarka Gallery, the Story of North Devon and the Regimental Collection of the Royal Devon Yeomanry. The £1.8 million extension will create new exhibition space, enabling the museum to display its 20th and 21st century collections for the very first time, as well provide improved educational facilities and a new cafe. This detailed development phase will enable the museum to apply for further funding from the Heritage Lottery Fund, North Devon Council, Central Government, and private donations, to deliver the project. If successful, the museum's new extension could be open by the summer of 2018.
